

HYDRANGEA paniculata 'GRANDIFLORA'

hardy white-flowered hydrangea, large-flowered paniculate hydrangea



Maintenance advice: Quite short pruning at the end of winter in order to have big clusters of flowers. Pruning is nevertheless

 not necessary. In April, remove dead and fragile wood, shorten the branches that has flowered 15 cm from their base in order to have large flowers.
