















# LIGUSTRUM ovalifolium

Korean privet, California privet, garden privet, oval-leaved privet



-  **Maintenance advice:** Prune it to the desired shape if necessary, at the end of winter or after the flowering in July. Pruning often suppressed the flowering of the year.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Japan; introduced in 1847 in California (US)
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 3 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Indifferent
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Semi evergreen
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Cream white
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Hedge, Country hedge, Free standing specimen
