-  **Maintenance advice:** In September, shorten the shoots to about a third of their length. Water regularly and abundantly the first year.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** China; introduced by Robert Fortune (UK) 1845
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** Yes

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Cream white
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Border, Country hedge, Free standing specimen
