Climbing honey-suckle, deciduous purplish leaves with scented yellow flowers.



**Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, shorten its thin branches to bring them closer to the main branches, if you wish to keep it compact. Limit its vegetation to the desired shape.



**Botanical/Horticultural origin:** China, Japan; introduced at the beginning of the 19th century.
