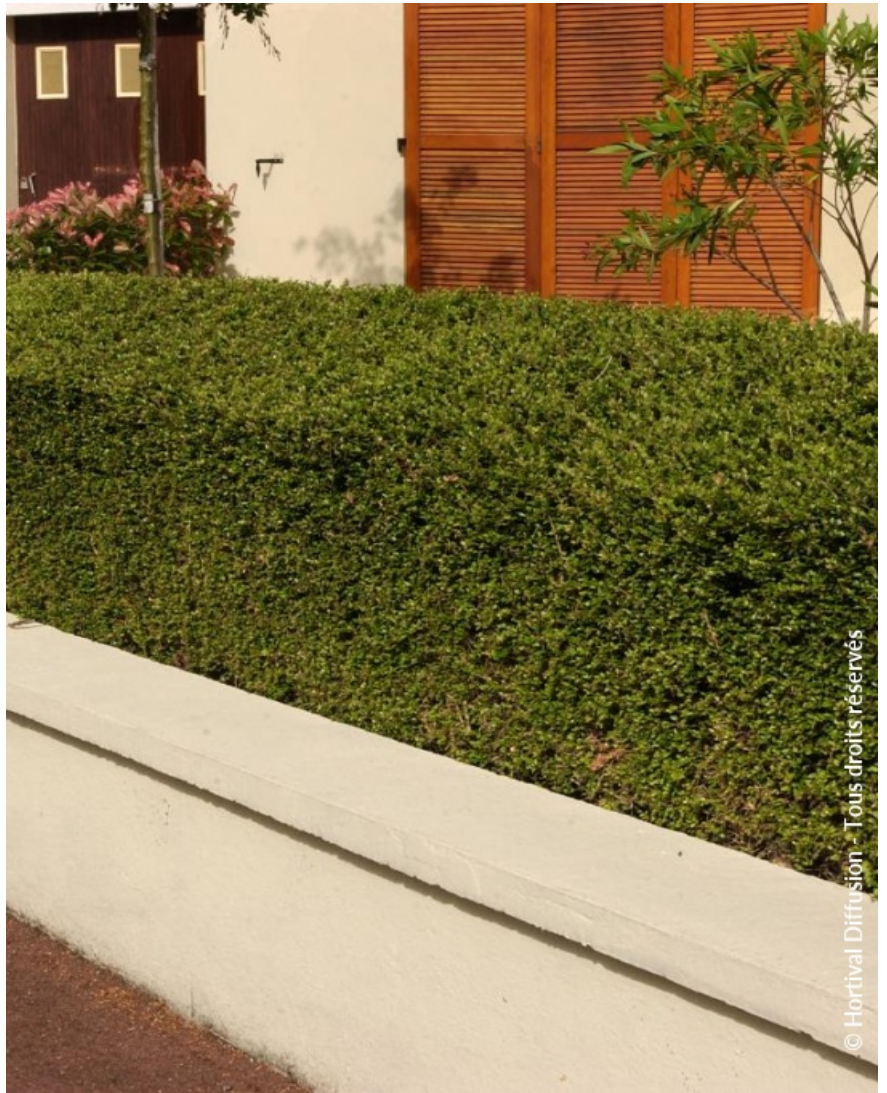


LONICERA nitida

box honeysuckle or Wilson's honeysuckle



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, prune it to the desired shape. Another pruning is possible in September if you wish your plant to have an impeccable shape. Shorten its fine shoots to keep it dense and compact with a regular shape. Prune it just a little or not at all if you wish to have a free shape. Pruning can remove the inconspicuous flowers and fruits.
