mile-a-minute plant, China fleece vine



Russian vine. A vigorous deciduous climber, green heart shaped leaves, profuse white flowers.



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, abundantly reduce its vegetation if necessary. It tolerates severe pruning in order to rejuvenate the plant and increase the flowering.
