Evergreen shrub with a profusion of white flowers followed by orange fruit.



Maintenance advice: Slightly prune the hedges and the sculpted shapes at the end of winter. The free shapes can be rejuvenate every 3 or 4 years if necessary. A severe pruning can limit or suppress the fruit production of the year.
