Rhododendron 'Amoena'



Evergreen hybrid azalea, compact, hardy, small mauve flowers.



Maintenance advice: The Rhododendron appreciates cool soils: keep the soil moist with regular watering in summer. In August-September, reduce the watering to enhance the flowering in the following spring.
