-  **Maintenance advice:** Prune hedges at the beginning of summer. To rejuvenate the shoots, prune a few old culms at their base in spring when the new shoots are growing.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** China, Japan, Taiwan; Introduced by Lodgies (UK) around 1825
