Japanese spirea 'Goldflame'



Deciduous hardy shrub. Young leaves reddish orange becoming yellow - Pink flower.



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, shorten the stems to 10-15 cm above ground surface. Water regularly and abundantly the first year.
