

SPIRAEA nipponica 'SNOWMOUND'

Tosa spirea 'Snowmound'



Deciduous hardy shrub. Green leaves covered in white flowers in June.



Maintenance advice: After the flowering, shorten the shoots that has flowered by a third or a half. After a few years, remove a few old branches at their base to lighten the clump and rejuvenate it.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: Japan; introduced in the USA in the 1950s
