lilac 'Katherine Havemeyer'



'Lilac'. Deciduous hardy scented flowering shrub. Double purple lavender flowers fading to pink.



**Maintenance advice:** After the flowering, prune the withered flowers without removing the buds. Water regularly and abundantly the first year.
