vitex, chaste tree, chastetree, chasteberry, Abraham's balm, lilac chastetree, monk's pepper



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, prune at least the withered flowers. If you want to keep it small and compact, you can prune very short the branches that has flowered, leaving only a few centimetres (3 eyes or buds).
