
















YUCCA filamentosa

-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, remove the dry leaves at its base. Remove the withered flower stems after flowering.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** South-eastern United States

-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Slow
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Full sun
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Evergreen
-  **Shape:** bush, spreading
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Cream white
-  **Soil type:** Dry
