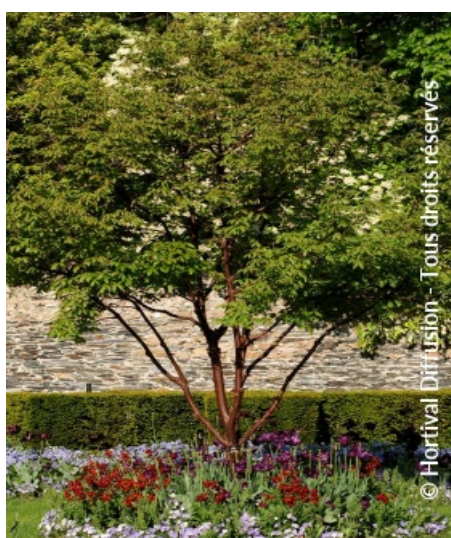


ACER griseum

Maintenance advice: Remove dead wood and prune the scaffolds from the end of summer to the beginning of autumn, to highlight the bark.
