

# VITIS coignetiae

crimson glory vine



**Maintenance advice:** Trellis the main branches. In winter, shorten the branches, leaving just 3 buds. In summer, reduce new shoots to control vegetation, so that the sun can colour the fruit. Nourish with organic fertilizer each year to maintain vegetation.
