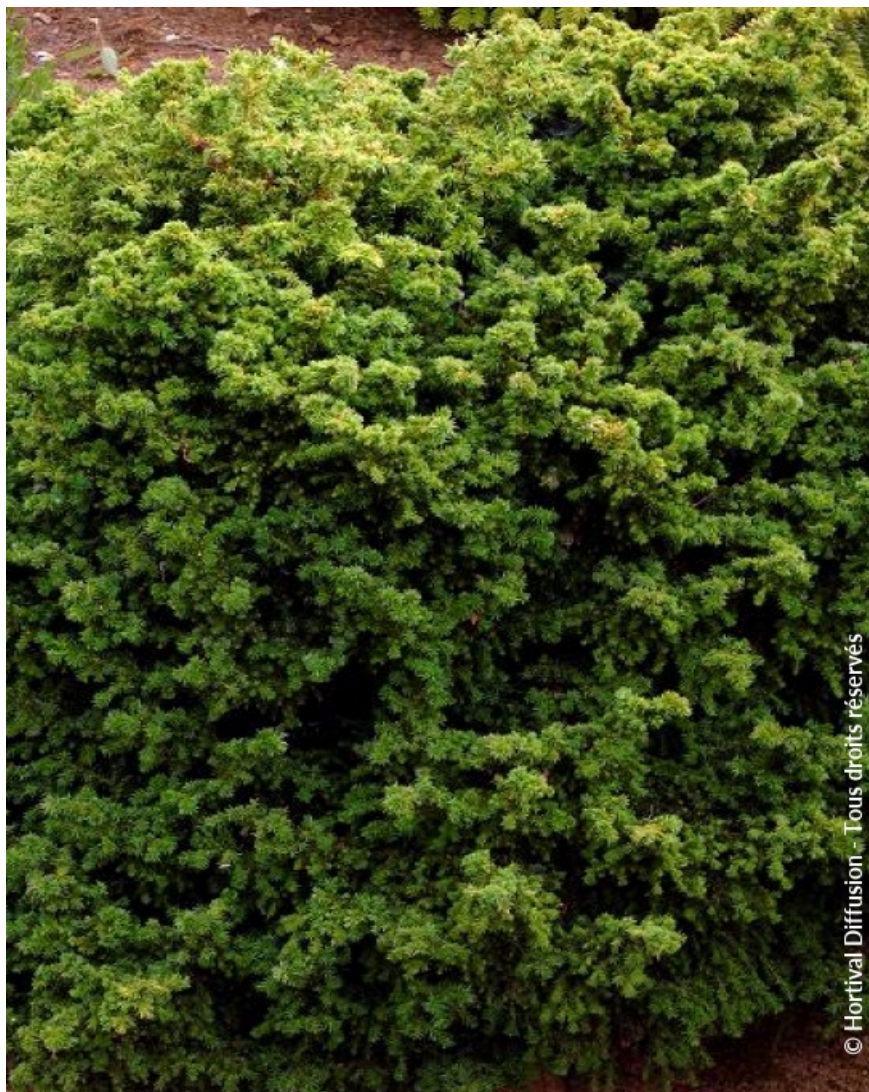


CRYPTOMERIA japonica 'VILMORINIANA'
