

HYDRANGEA serrata 'BLUE BIRD'

mountain hydrangeatea 'Blue Bird', Tea of heaven 'Blue Bird'



Dwarf deciduous shrub. Lacecap blue flowers. Excellent autumn colour.



Maintenance advice: In april, cut off any dead wood, the greying, older stems and wilted flowers. Keep the vigorous younger stems (with large buds). Water regularly in dry weather.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: Old horticultural selection from Japan.



Use group: Heathland plants



Height at 10 years: 1,5 m



Width at 10 years: 1 m
