Lavender : green leaves compact habit. Pink flowers.



Maintenance advice: After flowering, prune your lavender, without reaching any dried stems to keep it dense and compact.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: Introduced by Thomas Carlile, Loddon Nurseries (GB) before 1950.
