Vigorous semi-evergreen climber with white vanilla scented flowers, followed by sausage shaped fruit.

-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, to limit vegetation, if wanted. Add compost to the base in spring for more vigour, if necessary.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** China, Japan, Korea
-  **Use group:** Climbers
-  **Height at 10 years:** 4 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 3 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
-  **Fragrance:** Yes
