'Notbruce' cov

Himalayan honeysuckle [Golden Lanterns]



Deciduous shrub with golden leaves panicles of white flowers followed by red berries.



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, severely prune some of the old branches, just above a bud or another smaller branch on it, to renew them. Cut off all the parts touched by the cold (will easily produce shoots from the base). In case of prolonged periods of really cold weather, cover the ground at the base with straw.
