

WISTERIA venusta 'ALBA' (= brachy.'SHIRO KAPITAN')

silky wisteria



Hardy deciduous climber. Big white flowers on short fat racemes.



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, prune short, leaving 4 to 5 flower buds per branch (bigger and rounder than the leaf buds). In autumn trim the shoots to about 20cm.
