
ACER palmatum 'SANGOKAKU'

Coral bark Japanese maple, yellow orange foliage in spring then green. Lovely red branches in winter.

Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, cut down any dead wood. Pruning, not always necessary, can be done moderately, at the end of summer/beginning of autumn.
