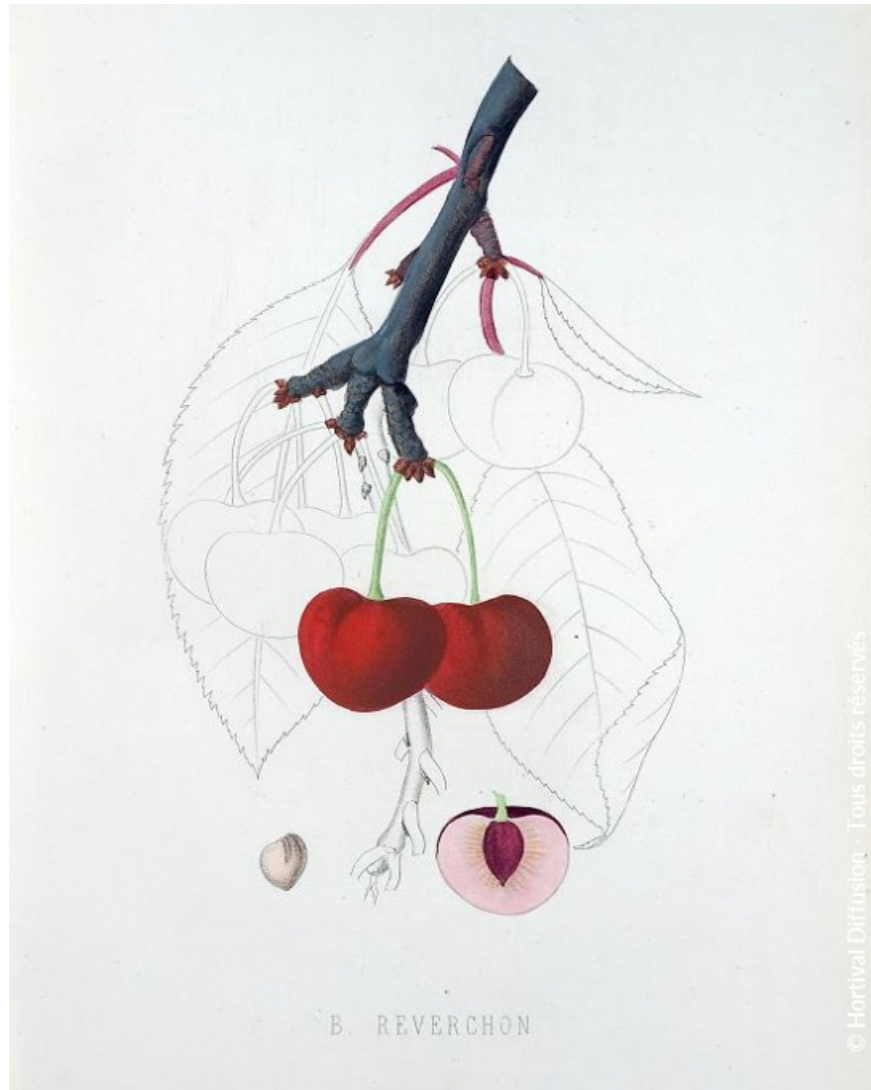


PRUNUS avium 'REVERCHON'

Maintenance advice: After harvesting, and only if necessary, give a formative pruning to even out, harmonize and ventilate branches. At the end of winter, cut off any dead wood. Cherry trees are only moderately pruned.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: Horticultural origin : imported from Italie, near Florence, around 1855 by Reverchon, an expert on edible fruit, from Lyon.
