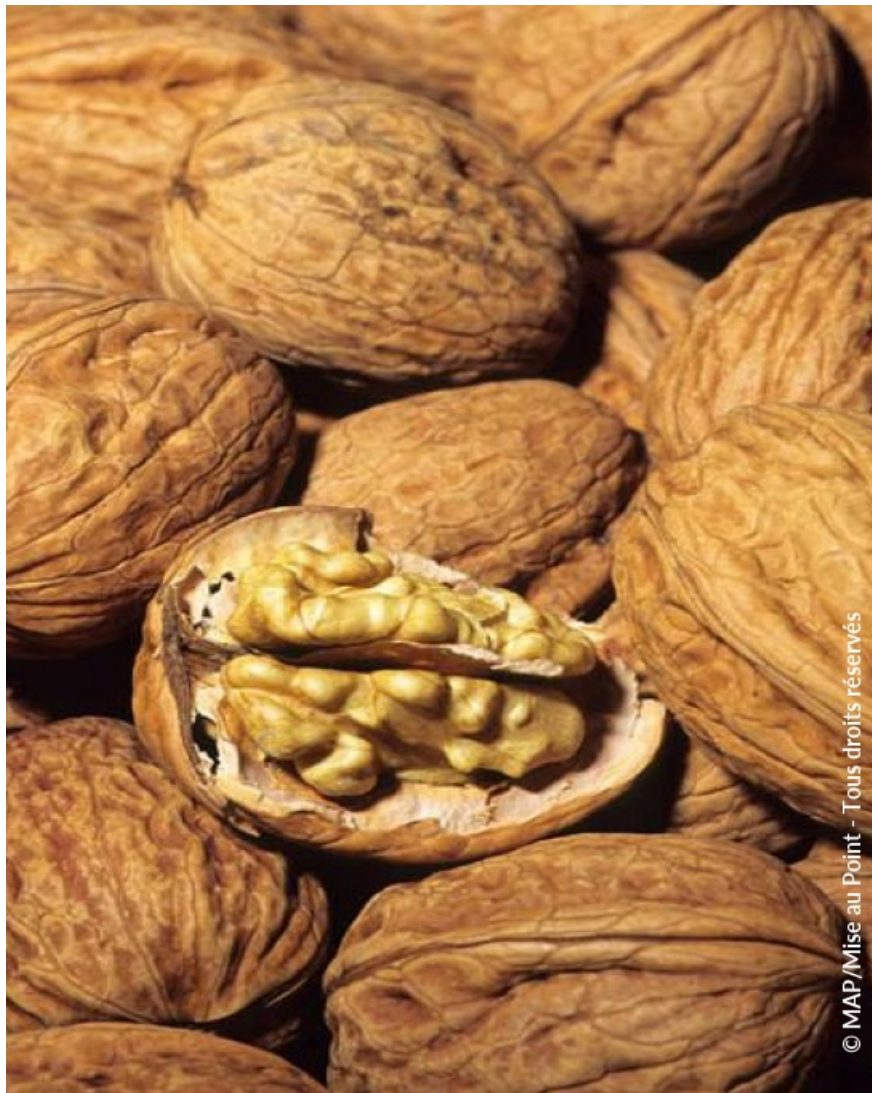


JUGLANS regia 'FRANQUETTE'

Grafted Walnut. Late season, thin shelled nut of great quality.



Maintenance advice: Cut off any dead wood in October-November. Moderately trim, if necessary, spreading a pruning sealer on wounds. A heavy pruning can be done, every 3-4 years, once the leaves have fallen in November.
