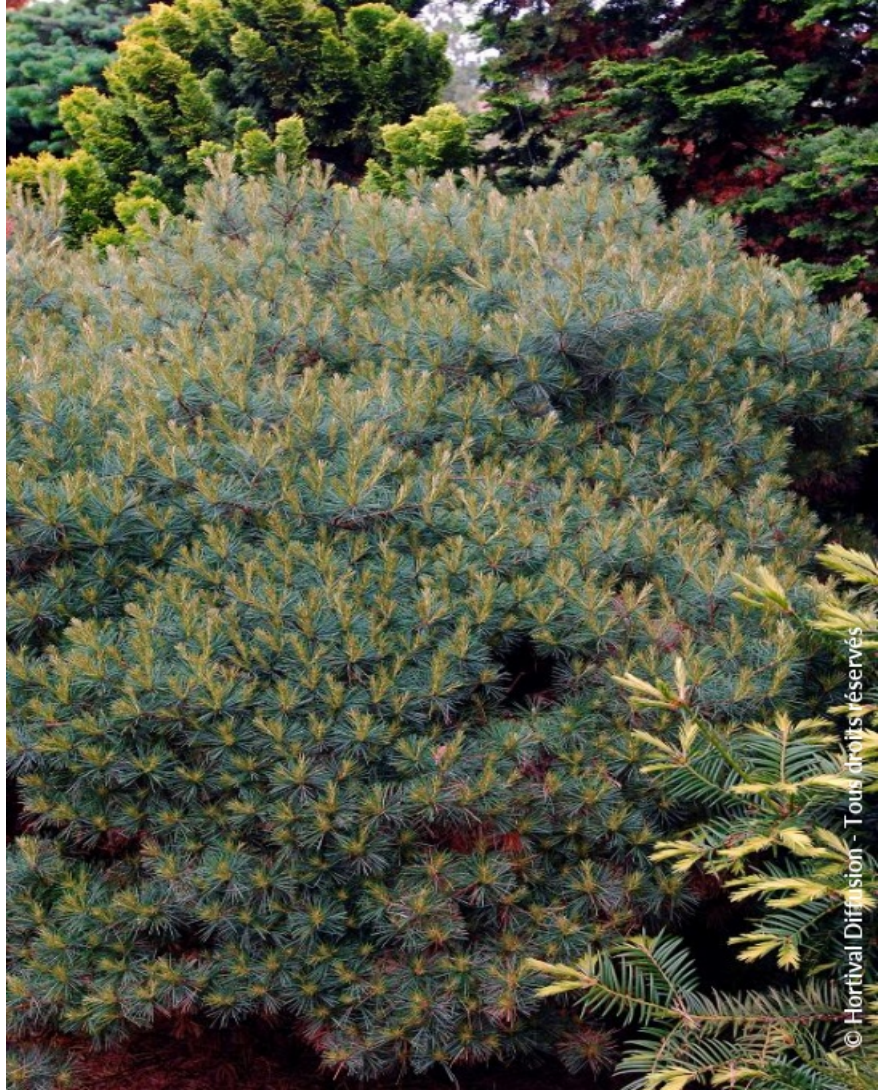
















PINUS strobus 'MINIMA'

-  **Maintenance advice:** Pruning is unnecessary for this variety. Water abundantly and regularly for the first 2 years, more, in very dry weather if in a container.
