-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** China : discovered in 1816-1817 by Clarke Abel (GB)
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** Yes

-  **Exposure:** Full sun
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** White
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
