

CORONILLA valentina ssp. glauca (selection)

Glaucous scorpion-vetch, Coronilla glauca, Coronilla valentina 'Glauca', Mediterranean crownvetch, Bastard senna



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, near March, prune to 60-80cm from the ground and remove any dead wood. Prune after flowering in spring to get an abundant repeat flowering in September. If not pruned, repeat flowering will be light but regular.
