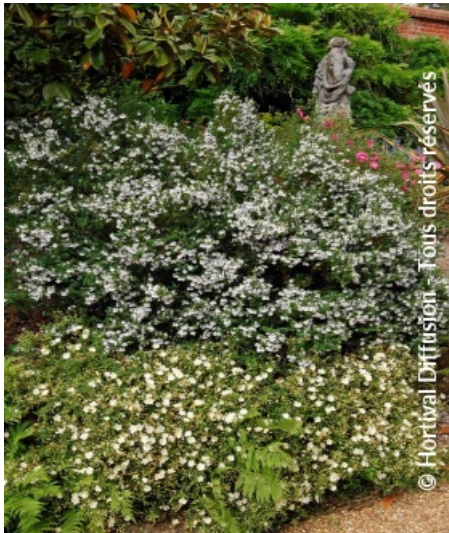


PROSTANTHERA cuneata

Maintenance advice: Lightly trim young shoots after flowering, only if necessary, to harmonize shape.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: Australia (Victoria, New South Wales), Tasmania (presumed extinct).
