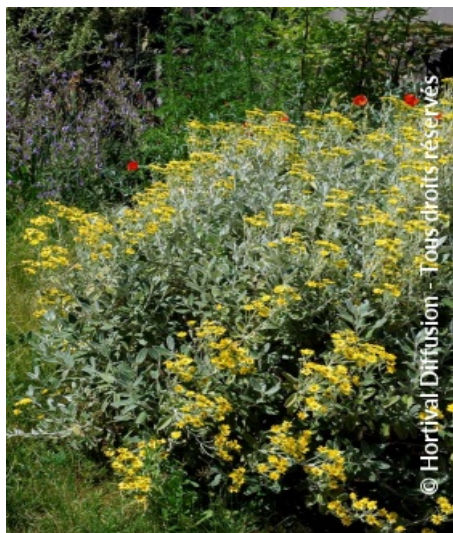


SENECIO compactus DRYSDALE

Senecio/Brachyglottis 'Drysdale', Daisy Bush



Maintenance advice: In summer, eliminate the dried flowers if wanted. After flowering, trim shoots lightly to maintain compact. A more severe pruning is possible at the end of winter.
