Grape Vine 'Blue Muscat '



Black dessert grape - selected for the quality of its fruit.



**Maintenance advice:** Trellis the main branches. At the end of winter, shorten the branches, above the third bud. In summer, reduce growth of new shoots so that the sun penetrates and colours the grapes and control vegetation.
