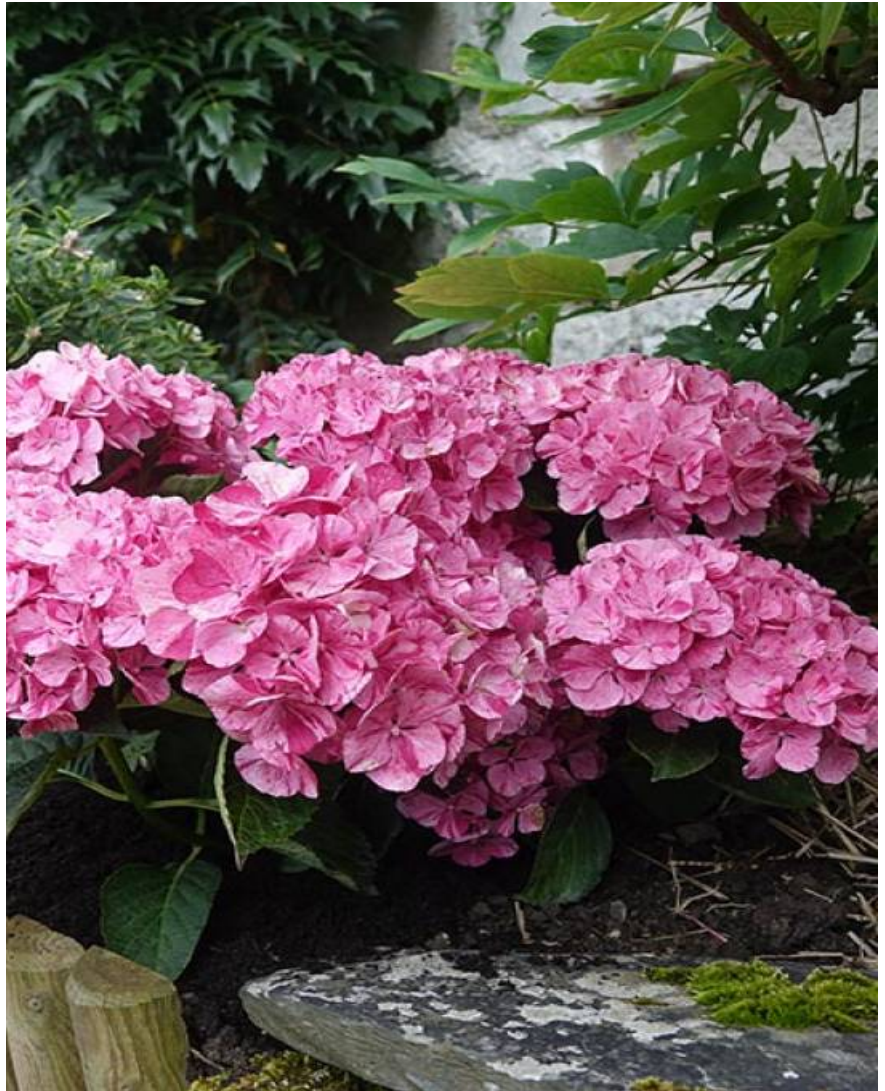


HYDRANGEA macrophylla PINKY BINDER (R)

Hydrangea PINKY BINDER®



Compact plant with streaked flowers, light pink to fuchsia.



Maintenance advice: Remove any dead or spindly branches at the end of winter. Appreciates mulching, 5cm thick, to stay fresh and help roots establish. A regular pruning to rejuvenate is beneficial, consisting of cutting the older greying stems just above large buds, at the end of winter.
