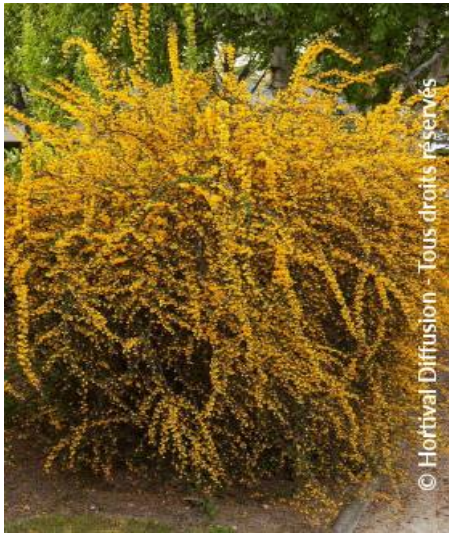


BERBERIS x stenophylla

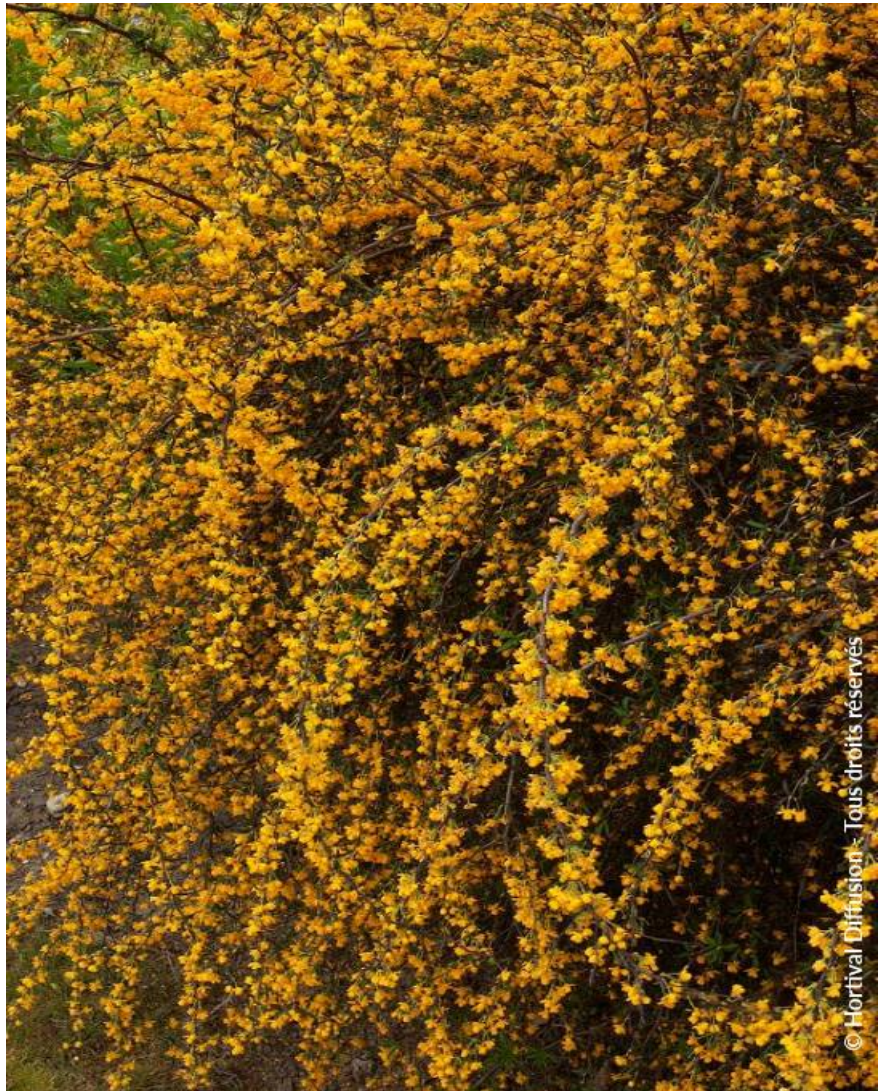
golden barberry, narrow-leaved barberry

-  **Maintenance advice:** Moderate pruning after flowering if necessary (especially for hedges). Unpruned plants remain graceful.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin; breeder Fisher & holmes (GB) around 1860
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Evergreen
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Yellow
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Free standing specimen, Hedge, Border
