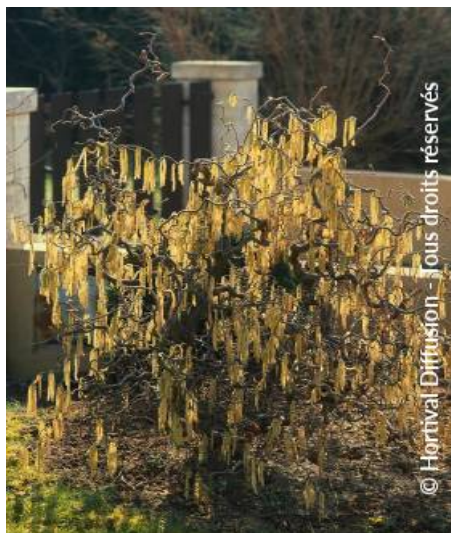


CORYLUS avellana 'CONTORTA'

Maintenance advice: Prune at the end of winter, if necessary.



Remove any straight shoots at its base (that can occur on grafted plants that are planted too close from the ground surface).
