-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, prune it slightly with shears, only if necessary, to limit its vegetation or keep it very compact.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** China; introduced by Ernest Wilson (GB) 1900

-  **Height at 10 years:** 0,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Growth:** Medium

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Evergreen
-  **Shape:** creeping, prostrate
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
