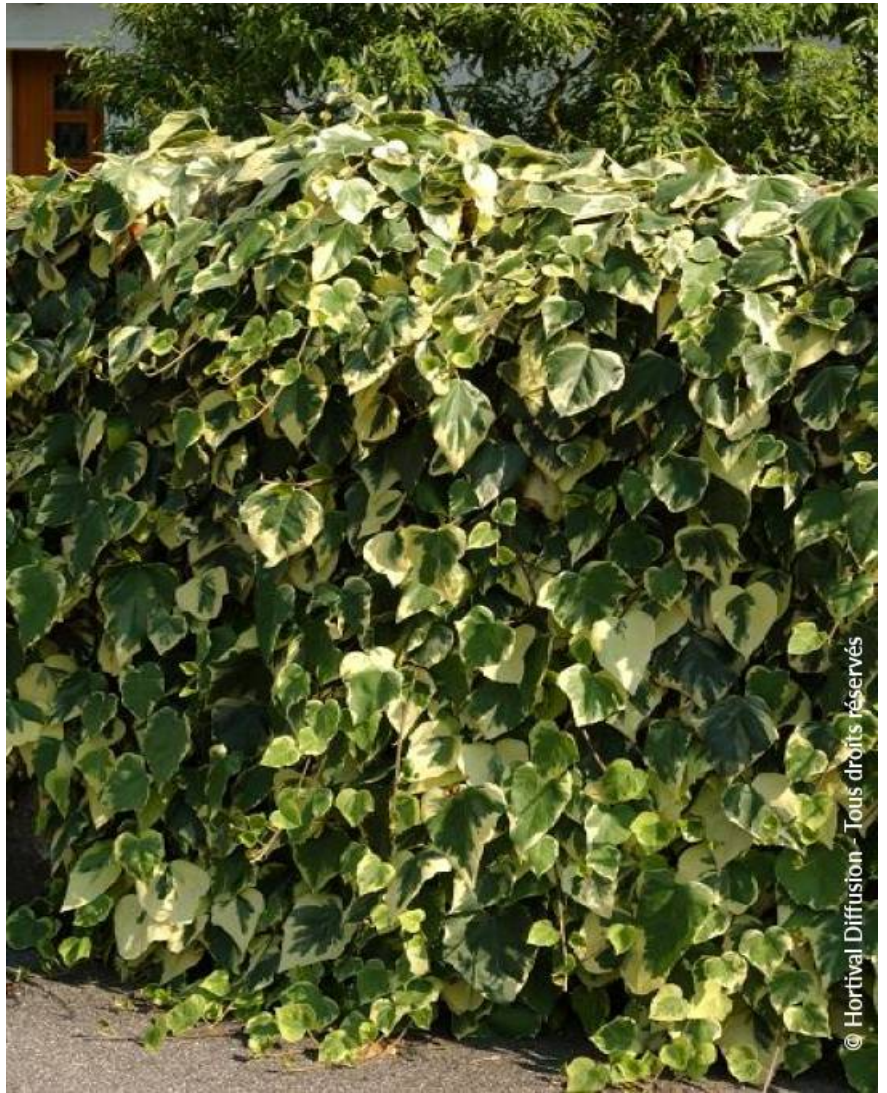

















HEDERA canariensis hort. 'GLOIRE DE MARENGO'
