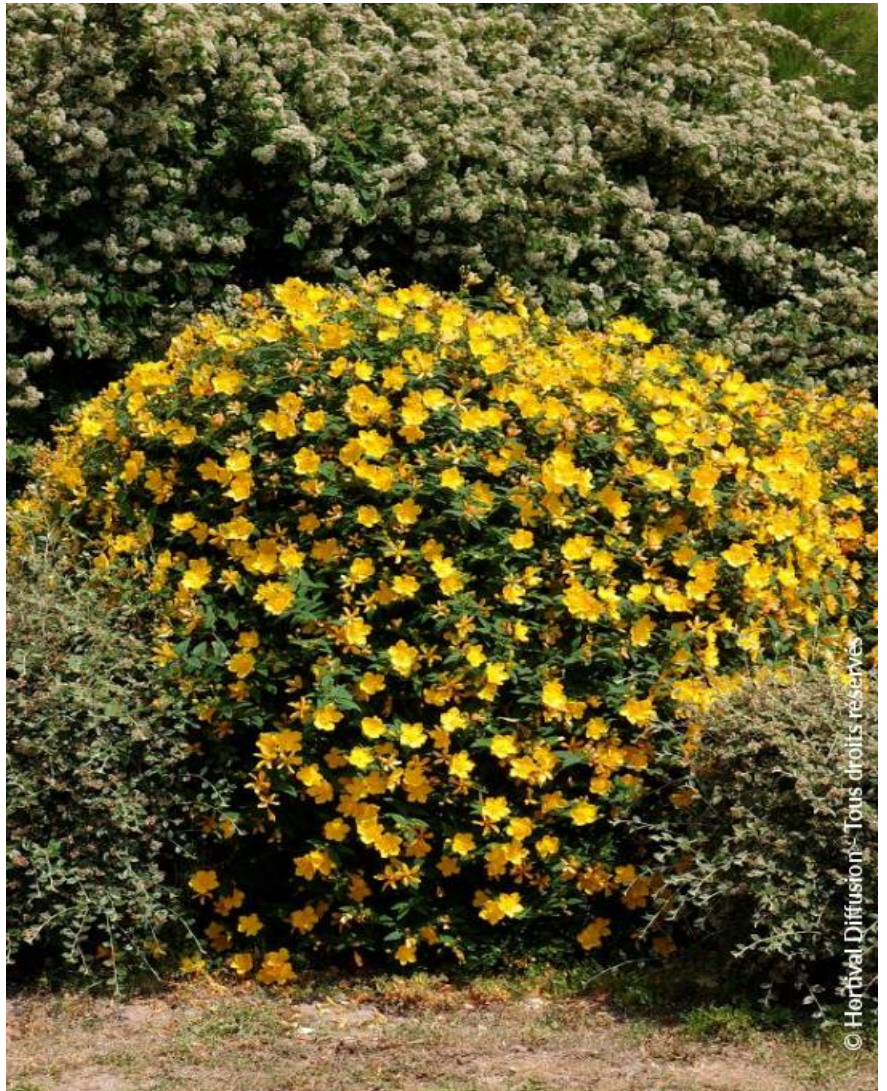
















HYPERICUM x hidcoteense 'HIDCOTE'

St John's wort 'Hidcote'



Hardy deciduous shrub, flowers yellow all summer.

-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, remove about a third of the length of the shoots.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin; bred in Hidcote manor (GB) before 1954
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Full sun
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Semi evergreen
-  **Shape:** rounded, ball, globe
-  **Colour of leaves:** Blue green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Yellow
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Border, Tub/container, Rockery
