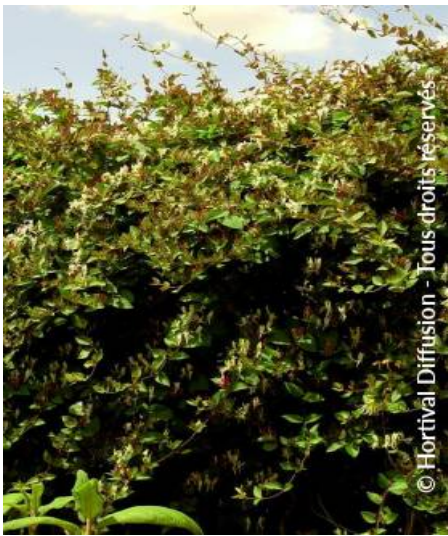


LONICERA japonica var.chinensis

Climbing honey-suckle, deciduous purplish leaves with scented yellow flowers.



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, shorten its thin branches to bring them closer to the main branches, if you wish to keep it compact. Limit its vegetation to the desired shape.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: China, Japan; introduced at the beginning of the 19th century.



Use group: Climbers
