Mock orange - deciduous large shrub free flowering, double white scented flowers.



**Maintenance advice:** In order to have a regular and compact shape, prune the shoots to 1/3 after flowering. For a more light, flexible and natural shape, remove a few old branches at their base every 2 to 3 years.
