-  **Maintenance advice:** Prune about 1/3 of the shoots after the flowering. Remove a few old branches every 3 to 4 years.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin; breeder Guy D. Bush (US) 1935
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
-  **Fragrance:** Yes

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** White
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
