

# WISTERIA floribunda 'VIOLACEA PLENA' (= 'BLACK DRAGON')

Japanese wisteria 'Violacea Plena', Japanese Wisteria 'Black Dragon'



Hardy deciduous climber. Flowers violet-blue double.



**Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, prune short by keeping 4 to 5 buds per branches (they are larger and rounder than leaf buds). In autumn, shorten the shoots to about 20 cm long.



**Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin; introduced from Japan by Francis Parkmann (US) 1869
