Mollis Azalea 'Gibraltar'



Deciduous hybrid orange Azalea. Free flowering with upright habit.



**Maintenance advice:** Azaleas appreciate cool soils: keep the soil moist with regular watering in summer. In August-September, reduce the watering to enhance the flowering in the following spring.
