
## **MORUS alba 'PENDULA'**

- Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, remove dead wood and a few branches that no longer see the light inside the tree because of younger branches hiding sunlight. Shorten branches that are too long.
- Botanical/Horticultural origin: Horticultural origin; bred in Italy around 1890.
- Use group: Trees
- † Height at 10 years: 4 m
  → Width at 10 years: 3 m
- Growth: Fast

- Exposure: Full sun

- Shape: weeping, pendulous
- Colour of leaves: Green
