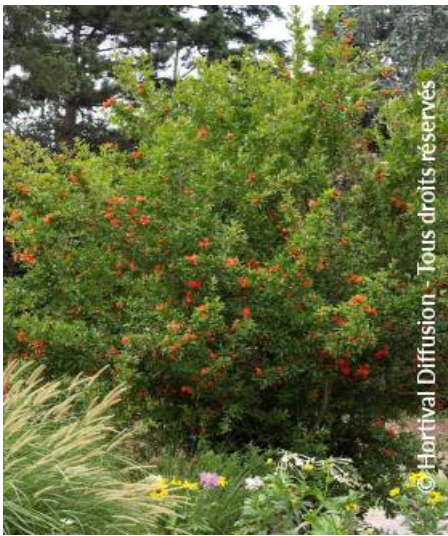
















# PUNICA granatum f. plena

-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter ridding the tree of dead or incumbent branches is sufficient. One can also cut off some of the many shoots coming from its base.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 3 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Full sun
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** rigid, upright
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Red
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Free standing specimen, Border, Tub/container
