

WISTERIA floribunda 'MACROBOTRYS'

Japanese wisteria 'Macrobotrys', Wisteria floribunda 'Longissima', Wisteria floribunda 'Multijuga'



Hardy deciduous climber. Lilac blue very long flowers often to 1m long.



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, prune short, leaving 4 to 5 flower buds per branch (bigger and rounder than the leaf buds). In autumn trim the shoots to about 20cm.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: Japan : introduced by Von Siebold (DE) around 1864.
