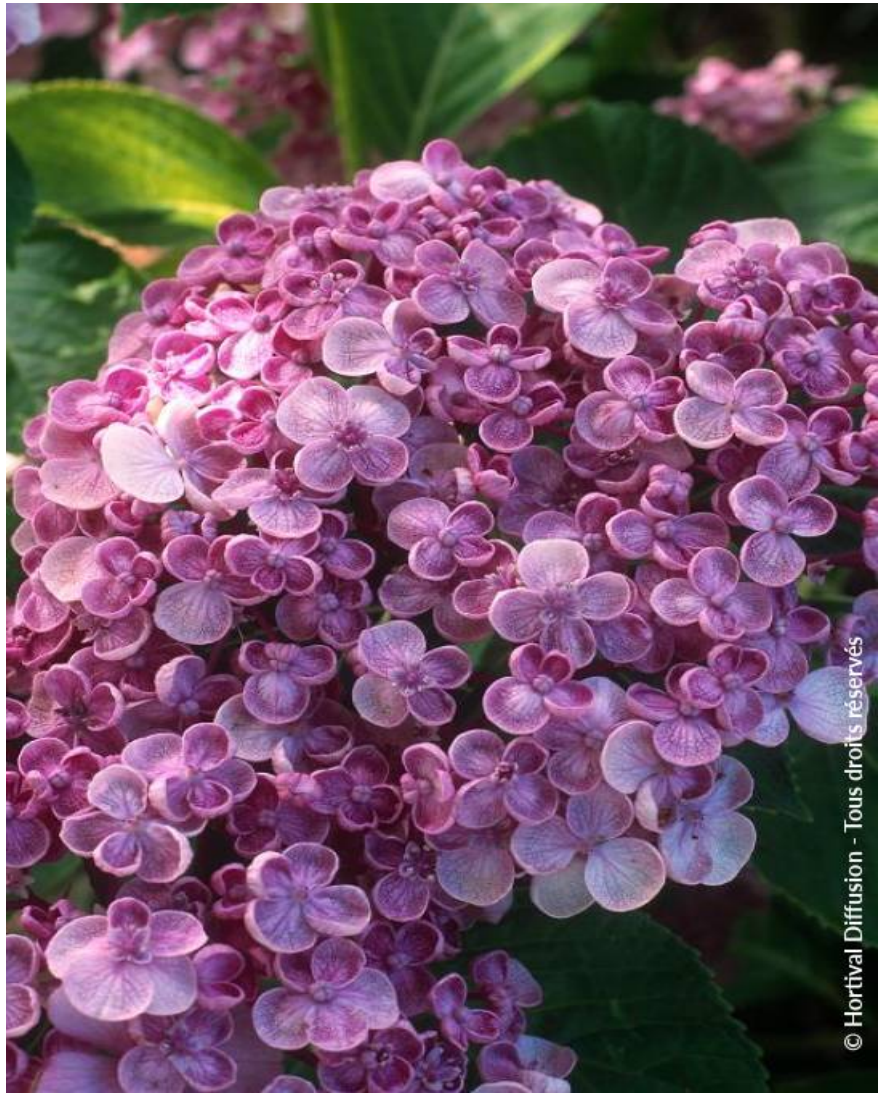

Lilac flowered Hydrangea, original flower slightly scented, strong green leaves.



Maintenance advice: In April, cut away any dead wood, the greying stems and wilted flowers. Keep the vigorous younger stems (with large buds). Water regularly in dry weather.
