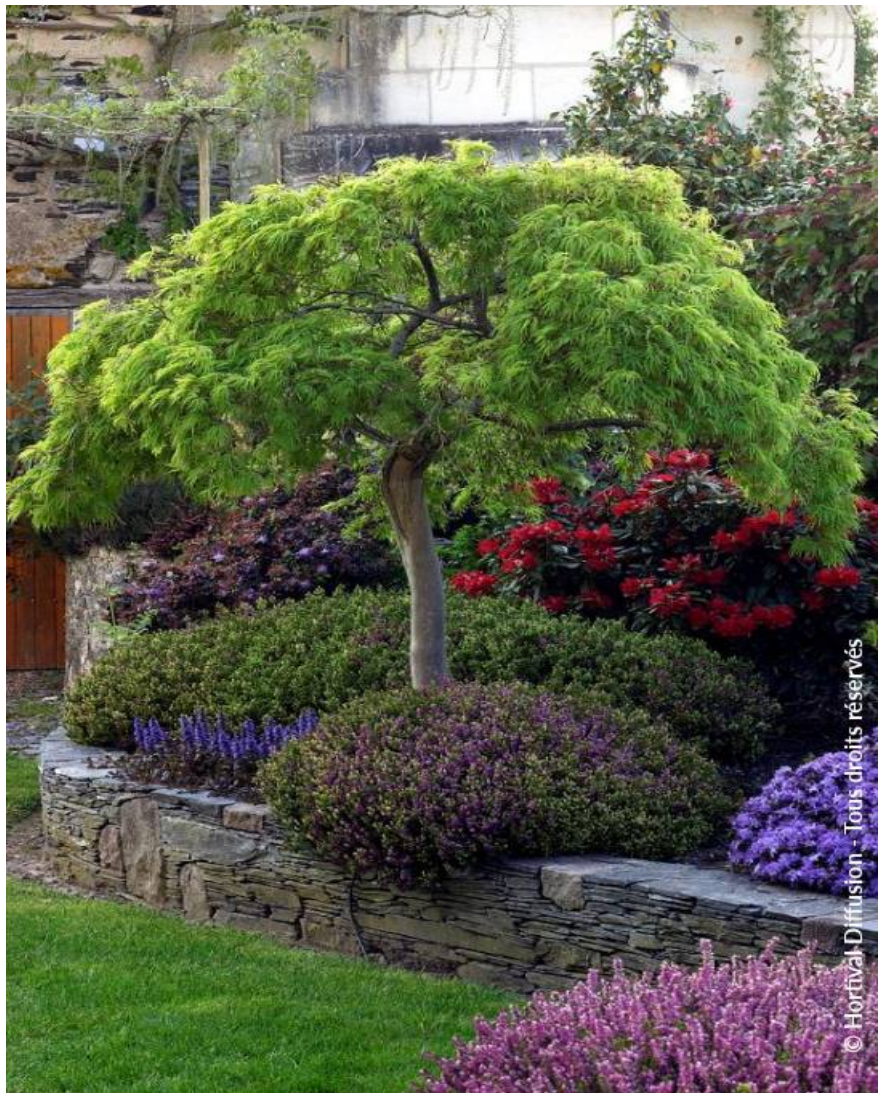
purple cut-leaved Japanese maple

A slow growing Japanese maple with deeply cut soft green leaves in spring, they turn darker green during the summer with yellow-orange autumn colour.



Maintenance advice: Remove any dead wood. Pruning is not necessary but can be done moderately between the end of summer and the beginning of autumn.
