A slow growing Japanese maple with deeply cut soft green leaves in spring, they turn darker green during the summer with yellow-orange autumn colour.



**Maintenance advice:** Remove any dead wood. Pruning is not necessary but can be done moderately between the end of summer and the beginning of autumn.



**Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : selected from old japanese gardens.
