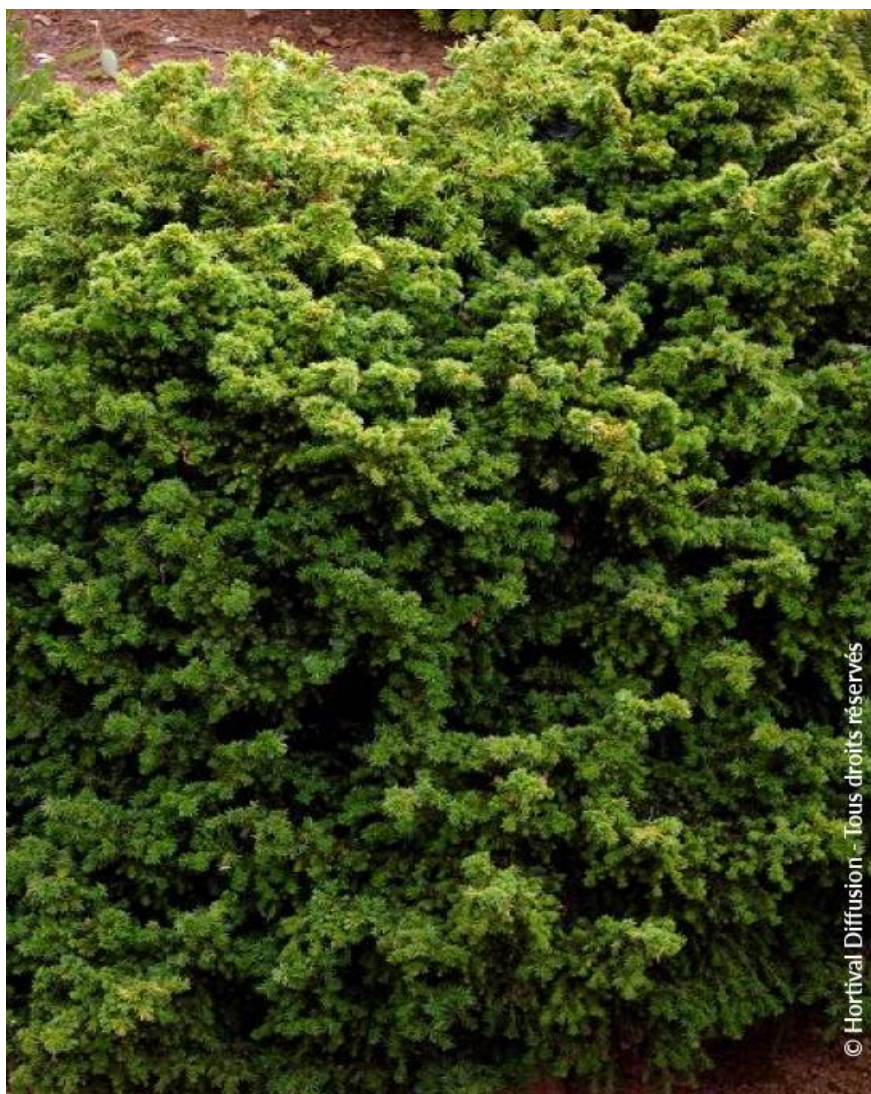










CRYPTOMERIA japonica 'VILMORINIANA'

-  **Maintenance advice:** Pruning is unnecessary for this variety. Water abundantly and regularly for the first 2 years.
