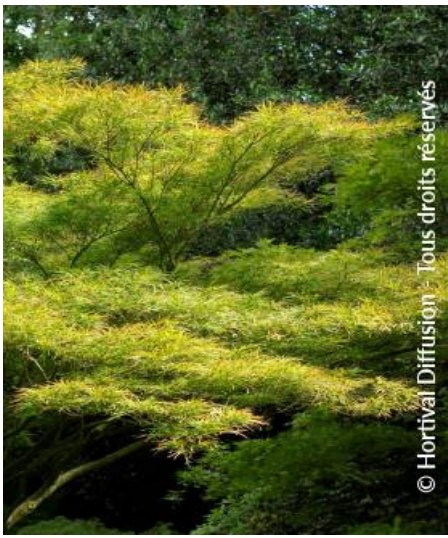


ACER palmatum 'VILLA TARANTO'

Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, remove any dead wood. Pruning is not often necessary, but can be moderately done, between the end of summer and beginning of autumn. Protect any finger-sized wounds with a pruning sealer.
